When a writer publishes a book independently without sharing the copyright and profit, it is called self-publishing. It is the most efficient publishing model of this time in which the author collaborates with a team of editing and publishing professionals to produce their work. As opposed to traditional publishing, a self-published author does not have to sign over the copyright and can exercise full authority on the manuscript at every stage of publication.

Examples of Self-publishing

Contrary to popular belief, self-publishing is not a new fashion. It has long been in practice for ages down through which authors have found the recognition and success they deserved. Johannes Gutenberg is credited to be the first self-publisher who published his work himself after introducing printing to the western world in 1440. Benjamin Franklin, the founding father of the United States of America, wrote and self-published an annual booklet 'Poor Richard's Almanack' which was a collection of essays, weather predictions and household tips. In the year 1789, British poet, philosopher, painter and visionary William Blake self-publishedhis monumental books Songs of Innocence, Songs of Experience, and The Marriage of Heavenand Hell.

British novelist Jane Austen had a few rejections before she resorted to the vanity publishing route, a new and popular concept in 1941. She paid a London-based publishing agent to get her novel 'Sense and Sensibility' published. The novel earned little recognition in its time but is taught extensively now as part of the academics in many universities worldwide. American poet and journalist Walt Whitman was alleged of writing outrageous content in his poem 'Song of Myself' but it is now considered amongst his greatest literary creations. The celebrated writer Virginia Woolf established Hogarth Press to publish her works as well as those of her contemporary writers.

Self-publishing and the Philosophy of the Time




